**DESCRIPTION**

Bone Morphogenetic Proteins (BMPs) belong to the TGF-beta superfamily of proteins. BMPs elicit their effects by signaling through serine/threonine kinase receptors and play key roles in the development of nearly all organs and tissues. BMP-4 plays a role in the development and maintenance of bone and cartilage.

**MOLECULAR MASS**

Recombinant murine BMP-4 is a fully active homodimeric protein consisting of two 106 amino acid subunits which correspond to amino acids 303-408 of the full length BMP-4 precursor.
